Toros Agripark facilities producing crucial young rootstock for fruit seedlings with tissue culture methods has exported its first products. Gisela Cherry young rootstocks and Wavit Plum young rootstocks produced successfully by the Tissue Culture Laboratory were exported to the German company CDB from Toros Agripark's facilities in Adana.

First exports from Toros Agripark facilities

Toros Agripark facilities producing young rootstock for fruit seedlings with tissue culture methods has exported its first products. Gisela Cherry and Wavit Plum young rootstocks successfully produced at the Tissue Culture Laboratory were exported to CDB (Germany) owner of the Gisela cherry rootstock variety's worldwide license.

Toros Agripark submitted a total of 21,000 young fruit rootstocks to CB, thus completing both cherry and plum orders in less than a year with the meristem culture method.

Shaping the future of Turkish Agriculture

Since its establishment, Toros Agripark has been working towards reducing Turkey's dependence on external suppliers of vegetable and fruit seeds. Toros Agripark facilities produce disease free, high quality, high yield young rootstocks of vegetable and fruit varieties The laboratory is currently working on cherry, banana, almond, peach/nectarine young plants aside from potato seed production.
