Tekfen Construction continues to build roads for Qatar

Tekfen Construction has completed many infrastructure projects in Qatar since 2005, and has recently signed an agreement with the State of Qatar for the construction of the Al Khor Expressway. Tekfen Construction has pledged to complete the turnkey project in 36 months.

Tekfen adds another prestigious project to its portfolio in Qatar. Tekfen Construction had signed a preliminary protocol with the State of Qatar last summer, after which the final agreement has also been signed for the 34-km long Al Khor Expressway project.

Signed by Mohammed bin Abdullah al Rumaihi, Minister of Municipality and Environment of Qatar, and Murat Gigin, Chairman of the Board of Tekfen Holding, under the auspices of Ahmet Arslan, Minister of Transportation of the Republic of Turkey, the preliminary protocol indicates that the Al Khor Expressway will be 34 km long, with ten lanes in both directions. Involving numerous junctions, viaducts, over- and under-passes, the project will be one of the most prestigious in Qatar.

The total cost of the project is 7.6 billion Qatari Riyals (approx. 2.1 billion US Dollars), doubling Tekfen Construction's backlog and constituting the biggest one-off contract in Tekfen Construction's 60-year history.

1.5-BILLION DOLLAR BUSINESS VOLUME IN QATAR

Tekfen Construction has been active in Qatar without interruption since 2005 and has reached a total business volume of USD1.5 billion, including projects such as the Qatar North Road Project Contract 2 and 3 for ASHGHAL (Qatar's Office for Public Works), the Ceremonial Road, and the Qatar North Road Bypasses and Addition-

al Junctions. As for the industry, Tekfen Construction has successfully built a Low-Density Polyethylene Plant for QAPCO, and a Crude Oil and Ethane Gas Transmission Pipeline for Qatar Petroleum.





A new pipeline project in Saudi Arabia

Tekfen Construction has signed a USD299million agreement with Saudi Aramco for the construction of a 33-km pipeline project between Yanbu and Jeddah. According to the agreement, Tekfen will carry out the project on an EPC basis and deliver it turnkey

The pipeline extends in the western part of the country, between Yanbu and Jeddah, comprising 20" gasoline and 24" jet fuel pipelines. The project is scheduled to be completed in 47 months.



On with the records

Tekfen Construction continues to break records at the TANAP project, crowning its expertise in pipeline engineering. Tekfen set the world record in the number of automated welds completed in a day, while also carrying out the longest horizontal drill in Europe for the Sakarya River pass.

Since its establishment in 1956, Tekfen Construction has completed numerous ambitious projects in pipeline engineering, and has recently broken a world record at TANAP (Trans Anatolian Natural Gas Pipeline) project. Tekfen, having already completed over 6000 kilometers of pipelines in many parts of the world, has successfully joined a 2000-meter pipeline in 14 hours, setting a new world record.

Tekfen Construction has undertaken the construction of Lot 3 in the TANAP project, the 1850-km pipeline that aims to meet the natural gas demand of Europe and Turkey, and has successfully completed a total of 145 welds with 5 welding stations and 16 welders in

one work day. This marks the greatest length of a 56"-pipeline joined at one go with flawless welding. In addition, a 5-km section of the welded pipeline was lowered in one piece, thus successfully completing a 10-km pipe-laying in a single day.

Tekfen Construction has also carried out the longest horizontal drill in Europe within the scope of TANAP. With a riverbed width nearly 1100 meters, the Sakarya River posed one of the toughest phases of the project, and was traversed underground using horizontal directional drilling technique. In terms of pipe diameter (56") and length (1100 m), this work constitutes the longest horizontal drill in Europe.

New Opportunities with Saudi Aramco

Saudi Aramco, the largest energy company in the world, has signed a memorandum of understanding with Tekfen Construction to invite the company to the tenders it will hold in the future.

At the 23rd World Energy Congress, held this year in İstanbul, Tekfen Construction and Saudi Aramco, the Saudi petroleum company, have signed a memorandum of understanding marking the intent of both parties to develop potential opportunities. Signed on October 11, 2016, the memorandum makes Tekfen Construction eligible to bid for the engineering, procurement, and construction works of Saudi Aramco's future projects.

The cooperation between Tekfen and Saudi Aramco goes back to the early 1990s. To date, Tekfen Construction has completed various projects such as the Hawiyah Natural Gas Pipeline, the Cuaima-Berri Ethane Gas Pipeline, the Harad Gas and Condensate Pipelines, Quad-1 Pipeline, and the Yanbu Refinery, successfully meeting the expectations of Saudi Aramco, which is known for its extremely high standards regarding quality and safety.

The use of laser scanning technology and 3D integrated engineering applications is more or less a requirement for such projects in order to create a minimum level of revision work on the site, to shorten project periods, and to ensure correspondence among documents produced as well as between these documents and the site itself.

Tekfen Engineering is the leading company in Turkey in this regard, offering considerable advantages to its clients in terms of cost, application, and time in revamp and greenfield projects. The article covers Tekfen Engineering's work in this field, emphasizing the increase in productivity, cost management, and process safety made possible through digitization in engineering, construction, and operation stages of existing plants with insufficient documentation.

THE APP IN SHORT

"Toros Farmer" is an agricultural decision support application that farmers can download for free on their smart phones, personal computers, and tablets; it provides specific suggestions of fertilization to the farmer for the field in question, and aims to help farmers carry out the right procedure at the right time through alerts based on accumulated field knowhow of scheduling for the meteorologically right moment. The app helps farmers use their limited resources correctly and increase their productivity; it leads to increases in savings and production through recommending the adequate fertilization based on coordinates of the field and instantaneous weather, soil, and plant conditions.

Farmers upload their information to the system and receive warnings for frost, storm, and excessive rain risks, while also obtaining important agricultural information concerning rainfall and temperature. "Toros Farmer" app is available to all farmers regardless of whether or not they are Toros clients, and the simple and easy-to-use app aims to reach a wide range of users. The app makes it easier for farmers to be prepared for climate change, and by providing them a continuous flow of information regarding crops, weather conditions, and yield, it also aims to establish stronger bonds and communication between Toros and the farmers.

More accident-free days



The first piece of good news on accident-free performance came from BTC Pipelines and Facilities Repair Work Project. A total of 4.1 million man-hours (in other words, 3100 days or 8 years) have been completed accident-free at the project involving the 1071-km long BTC Pipeline. This achievement is made all the more remarkable when the extensive region the project covers and the tough climate conditions are taken into consideration.

2 million accident-free man-hours without time loss have been clocked at the TANAP Pipeline Project, and another 1 million man-hours at the TANAP Compressor and Metering Stations. Vehicles used in the project have travelled 1 million km without any serious accident. Our client TANAP has presented the project team with a plaque noting these achievements.

30 million man-hours without any accidents leading to loss of workday have been completed at the Shah Deniz Stage 2 Sangachal Land Terminal in Azerbaijan. During his site visit, Bruce Luberski, Vice President of BP, presented the project management with a certificate

in recognition of the outstanding performance. In addition, 22.8 million accident-free man-hours have been recorded at the Shah Deniz Platform Construction Project.

Another piece of good news came from the Qatar North Road Bypasses and Additional Junctions Project. Tekfen Construction has attained 16.3 million accident-free man-hours in this challenging project, and received the "Outstanding Contribution to Safety by a Contractor Award" at the Qatar Transport Safety Forum held between October 17 and 19, 2016.

4.9 million accident-free man-hours have been completed at the Sadara Propylene Oxide Plant Construction and Fitting Works Project in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. And last but not least, 4.3 million accident-free man-hours were reached at the Ceyhan Steel Fabrication Plant.
